Rules:

1. Entries accepted on Friday, September 29, 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Walker County Ag Center.
2. Entries may be removed on Saturday, September 30 between 7 p.m. and 8 p.m. Entries not picked up will be discarded. First, Second, and Third Place ribbons will be awarded.
3. All entries shall be of marketable size and quality.
4. All entries must be entered by the grower of the produce.
5. Entries will be judged prior to the opening of the festival on September 30.
6. All entries will be placed into one of the following classes. The number in parenthesis () indicates amount of produce per entry.
7. The festival will provide plates to place entries on.
