



Needlework/Quilting

Rules:

1. Entries will be received on Friday, September 29 from 5 pm – 8 pm.
2. Upon registration, each exhibitor will be required to fill out entry tags.
3. Each exhibitor is allowed one entry per class.
4. All needlework/quilting must be produced by the exhibitor
5. The utmost care will be taken in hanging and displaying of needlework and quilts. The Walker County Ag Festival and /or volunteers will not be responsible for mishaps or damages.
6. Judging will take place on Saturday, September 30 from 8:00-9:00 am and will not be open to the public.
7. 3 places and ribbons will be awarded in each class
8. Entries will remain on display until 7:00 pm, Saturday September 30 and can be picked up between 7:00 pm and 8:00 pm.
9. Any items remaining after the festival ends will be donated or discarded.
