Online entries should include: Name of student, address, phone number, school and grade. Check in is from 5:00-8:00pm, Friday, Sept. 29. Judging will be held Saturday. Posters will remain on display until 7:00 pm on Saturday, Sept 30.

All posters must be ½ size or the smaller poster size. No full size posters please!

ARBA- the American Rabbit Breeders Association is a good resource for information.

K-2nd grade – Pick your favorite breed of rabbit. Include on your poster: the name of the breed, a hand drawn colored picture of the rabbit breed, a few characteristics of the breed.

3rd-5th grade – Pick your favorite breed of rabbit. Include on your poster: the name of the breed, a hand drawn colored picture of the rabbit breed, important characteristics of the breed, how to care for this particular breed of rabbit.

6th – 8th grade – Pick your favorite breed of rabbit. Include on your poster: the name of the breed, a hand drawn colored picture of the rabbit breed, important characteristics of the breed, how to care for this particular breed and how this breed of rabbit is used.

9th – 12th grade – Pick a breed from the ARBA website. Include on your poster: the name of the breed, a hand drawn colored picture of the rabbit breed, important characteristics, breed care, uses for the breed and where the breed originated.

Ribbons will be awarded to all participants. A “Best of Show”, “Reserve Best of Show” and placings will be awarded in each age category.
